Once you have successfully completed the Communications in ADR course, the next course is the [National Introductory Mediation](#) course. This 40-hour course prepares you to effectively facilitate the interest-based mediation approach to resolving disputes. This course includes a take home quiz and a role-play skills evaluation.

### How to Register for Courses

Before registering for courses, you will need an ADRIA membership. As an ADRAI member, you will get an ADRIA organizational learner membership at no cost. There is no application process, simply [signup](#) as an Associate Member and select invoice (do not pay). Then email [membership@adralberta.com](mailto:membership@adralberta.com) to notify us that you have signed up and introduce yourself as an ADRAI member. Once we connect with ADRAI to confirm your membership, we will change your membership and void the membership invoice.

Once you have signed up for a membership then you can register for courses. You do not need to wait for ADRIA and ADRAI to confirm your membership to register. Our class sizes are small and many of our courses tend to fill up quickly, so we recommend you sign up early. For our Communications in ADR and National Introductory Mediation courses, we will add new dates as the courses fill up. Advanced courses are typically only offered once per year. Note: all course hours are Mountain time.
